Did You Know?

Alcohol was a factor in almost **40% of fatal car crashes** in Eau Claire County in 2018 (compared to 30% nationwide).

In 2018, **9 people died and 32 people were hospitalized because of opiates** like heroin or fentanyl. This is the highest number we have ever experienced in Eau Claire County.

Did you know about **185 people die every year from drugs or alcohol** in Eau Claire County, which is significantly higher than the rest of the state?
