In our last Newsletter, a call for Action was requested of our Women's Giving Circle Members about the fact that our circle has been growing smaller. Just prior to the COVID19 closures, we were

proud to have broken the three-hundred-member mark! Currently, our membership total is near two hundred, a full third less than at the end of 2019. Because the amount of granting help that we provide to non-profit organizations is based on a percentage of our members' annual contributions, this year we are not able to provide the level of support to deserving women and Children that we have in the past. We would be most grateful if you could help by:
