

CHILDREN'S SERVICE SOCIETY OF WISCONSIN - BUILDING FAMILIES

With a \$6,000 grant in 2020, Building Families was able to help ensure families served by the program were able to get many basic needs met. Building Families is a home visiting program serving families with children prenatal until the child enters kindergarten. COVID-19 added additional strains and challenges for families especially as many were already in poverty prior to the pandemic. Grant funding was used to purchase childproofing safety supplies, diapers, wipes, backpacks, thermometers, gas cards, grocery cards, breastfeeding supplies, bedding, storage supplies to organize potential child hazards, winter clothing and activities to help alleviate the activity burden on caregivers that are having to constantly provide every activity for their child.
