

PREVENTATIVE HEALTH

Support initiatives that promote healthy lifestyles and prevent illness. From community fitness programs to nutrition education.

MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS

Fund programs that provide mental health services, counseling, and support for those struggling with mental issues.

ACCESS TO HEALTHCARE

Support outreach programs that provide medical services to underserved populations.

HEALTH AND EDUCATION ADVOCACY

Invest in health education programs that inform the community about various health issues, prevention strategies, and available resources.

HOSPICE/END OF LIFE CARE

Fund services that provide compassionate, holistic support to individuals facing terminal illnesses, that they receive dignified end-of-life care.







GRANTMAKING

The Physicians' Community Impact Fund (PCIF) operates in alignment with the Eau Claire Community Foundation's established distribution rate, determined by the average market value of a fully funded fund over the previous twenty quarters. The annual distribution amount is calculated using this rate and the quarter-end balances as of December 31 of the preceding year.

PCIF INVESTMENT

PCIF Funds are held as a Field-of-Interest Fund at the Eau Claire Community Foundation and invested in a Long-Term Diversified portfolio with ECCF's primary money managers, Morgan Stanley Graystone. Following ECCF's distribution policy, a percentage of the fund's balance will be granted through a competitive grant process. The Physicians' Community Impact Fund uses a dedicated Grants Committee to carefully evaluate and select the most impactful projects submitted for funding consideration. This committee, composed of physicians and healthcare experts, reviews all grant applications and determines the finalists based on their potential to address critical community health needs. Each April, these finalists are presented to the general membership of the fund, who then vote to decide which projects will receive funding. This process ensures that grant decisions reflect the collective priorities and values of the fund's membership.

SECURITIES

Gifts of stock that have been held for more than a year may offer additional tax benefits related to your capital gain. Securities accepted as charitable gifts will be valued at the mean market value on the date of the gift. After the security is liquidated, the remaining value of the gift is available to support your charitable goals. Please note "Physicians' Community Impact Fund" when requesting a gift of stock through your brokerage.
