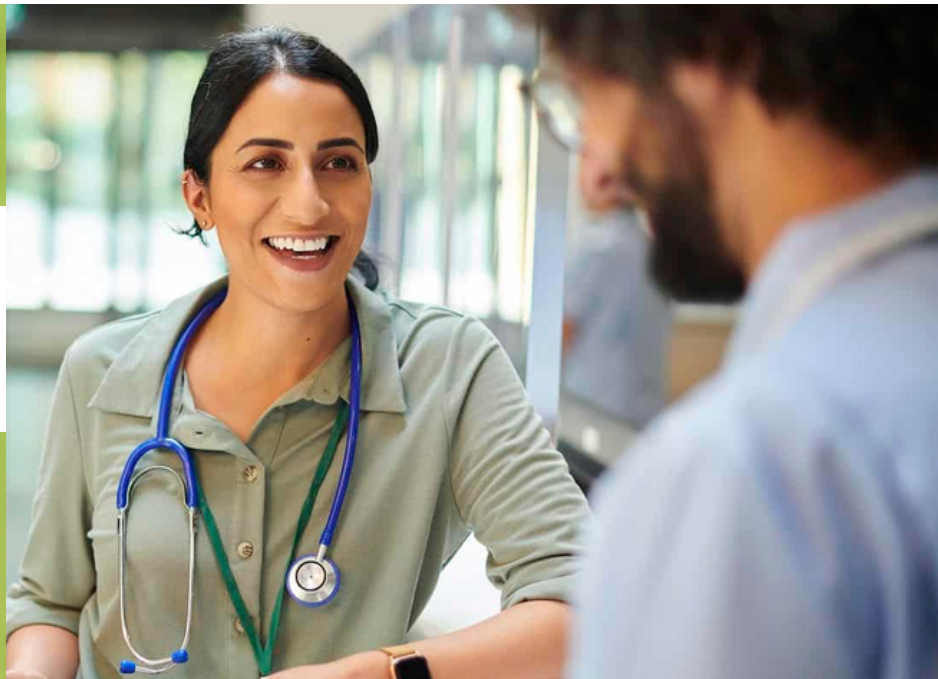

2025 GRANT RECIPIENT

May 5, 2026: Physicians' Community Impact Fund Awards First Grant to CVTC Foundation's Summer Dental Clinic

The Eau Claire Community Foundation is honored to announce the first grant awarded through the Physicians' Community Impact Fund (PCIF). The fund's first grant, in the amount of \$15,000, will support increasing access to dental care for children through the CVTC Dental Clinic's Summer Clinic. This funding will help expand the clinic from two days per week to three, allowing more low-income children to receive preventive dental care during the summer months, when they do not have to worry about missing school.

Over the course of six weeks, dental hygiene students, supervised by licensed faculty and a dental preceptor, will provide exams, cleanings, fluoride treatments, dental sealants, oral health education, and electric toothbrushes to 108 children who may otherwise go without care. The clinic also maintains a weekly waitlist of approximately 50 individuals, demonstrating the ongoing need for accessible dental services in the community.

"This first grant is a wonderful reflection of what can happen when people come together around a shared commitment to community health," said Dr. Susan Rowe, Chair of PCIF. "Improving access to preventive dental care for children is an investment not only in their health today, but in their well-being for the future. We are grateful to the physicians who made this possible and to the CVTC Dental Clinic for the care they provide to children and families in our community."

The Eau Claire Community Foundation is grateful to the members of PCIF for their generosity and vision, and to the CVTC Dental Clinic for helping meet an important need in the Eau Claire area.

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GRANTMAKING

The Physicians' Community Impact Fund (PCIF) operates in alignment with the Eau Claire Community Foundation's established distribution rate, determined by the average market value of a fully funded fund over the previous twenty quarters. The annual distribution amount is calculated using this rate and the quarter-end balances as of December 31 of the preceding year.

PCIF INVESTMENT

PCIF Funds are held as a Field-of-Interest Fund at the Eau Claire Community Foundation and invested in a Long-Term Diversified portfolio with ECCF's primary money managers, Morgan Stanley Graystone. Following ECCF's distribution policy, a percentage of the fund's balance will be granted through a competitive grant process. The Physicians' Community Impact Fund uses a dedicated Grants Committee to carefully evaluate and select the most impactful projects submitted for funding consideration. This committee, composed of physicians and healthcare experts, reviews all grant applications and determines the finalists based on their potential to address critical community health needs. Each April, these finalists are presented to the general membership of the fund, who then vote to decide which projects will receive funding. This process ensures that grant decisions reflect the collective priorities and values of the fund's membership.

SECURITIES

Gifts of stock that have been held for more than a year may offer additional tax benefits related to your capital gain. Securities accepted as charitable gifts will be valued at the mean market value on the date of the gift. After the security is liquidated, the remaining value of the gift is available to support your charitable goals. Please note "Physician's Community Impact Fund" when requesting a gift of stock through your brokerage.
